

29. Limitation

Limitation is one of the Most Common Concepts of the Third Dimension. Man always Sees Limits Wherever He Looks. Rare is the Person Who Can See and Think and Act Beyond the Limits Commonly Set on this Earth.

A few, the Inventors, the Creators, the Great Artisans and Artists, the Great Philosophers and Explorers, and Some Others that we can think of and name, have been Able to Break the Bonds of Limitation in One Way or Another. They have Looked Beyond the Boundaries and Seen Not Only Greener Grass but a Different Way, a Better Way.

Then come the Light People, the Bearers of Light, those who Know the Light and Love of God, those who Understand that God is Not the Limited Being that has been Pictured and Discussed and Taught about Over the Centuries, but He IS Limitless. He is Everything. He is Us.

The Knowledge Bursts All Bonds Of Limitation For If We Are Part and Parcel God, Then We Too Are Limitless!

Read on then and See what the Lord Jesus Sananda has to Say about the Subject of Limitation.

Dear One, the Concept of Being Limited or of Limitation is a Very Real Think for the Children of Men. Without their Being Aware or Knowing It, they are Subject to Limitation in Every Way and Every Aspect Upon the Earth Plan. This Means they are Not Aware that God is Everything. They have a Limited Idea and Picture of God. They are Not Aware that God Dwells Within Each of Them and that They Are a Part of the Godhead. They Consider Themselves Limited in this Respect While God is Limitless.

They see Limitation in Material Things about Them. Nature is Limited to Them, Confined to the Earth and its Nearby Space Neighbors, the Sun, Moon, Planets and a few Stars. They see Limitation in their Role on Earth. They see their Role as Very Tiny and Not Very Effective. They are Not Aware that for the Light Person, the Universe Rearranges Everything to Bring Their Payers To Pass. "Whatsoever ye Shall Ask the Father in My Name, He Will give It You." Man does Not Know That and, Sad to Say, Even when He Hears It, He Often Does Not Believe It.

Man's Senses are Limited. He Uses only the Five Senses and a Few the Sixth, but there are May More He Isn't Even Aware of. Man Doesn't Know of the Many Dimensions that Exist Beyond the Third Dimension which is Limitation Personified.

In the Third Dimension there is Time, a Limiting Concept. There is Space, another Limiting Concept. There are Boundaries, more Limitation. There are Edges, Another Limitation. There is a Span of Life, still Another Limit. Man Surrounds Himself with these Limits because He is Afraid and in His Fear He Arbitrarily Sets Limits, for Limits are Comforting and Safe Feeling and Provide some Sense of Security. In Every Way, Man Limits Himself and All the Things About Him. No Matter Where One Looks, One Will See Limitation In One Way or Another.

When, however, the Children of Men Begin to See the Light of God within Themselves, when He Perceives the Love of God that Dwells, Inside. Always, then, Man Begins to Break the Limitations that He Has Set for Himself. He Begins to Know God, not as a Separate Being Out in Space Somewhere But As Everything There Is In Every Universe In Existence Everywhere. He Throws Off the Limits that Have Been Set Upon the Concept of God and Begins to Understand True Reality, the True Being of God and that is that He is Literally Everything.

In other ways also Man Begins to Break the Limitations He Has Set Upon Himself, when He Sees the Light and Love of God Within. He Sees Himself as Not a Helpless, Sad, Unworthy, Unappreciated Being Nor as only One Among Billions of Other Such Weak, Ignoble Beings Upon the Earth but as Part of God. He Begins to Realize that If God is Everything Then He Himself Is Part of God for He is Included in Everything. Oh how this Understanding Opens His Eyes and Changes His Perception of Himself and the World about Him!

Man also begins to Break the Limitation He Has Set Upon What He Can Do. He Realizes He is Not Alone in the World but is Part of God and Has the Promise and Will and Love and Power of God to Use and to Call Upon. Man Literally Changes History, the World, and the Universe When He Asks for Blessing for Himself and Others.

In Respect to Time, Man begins to See the Faintest Glimmerings of what Eternity Is and that It Is There for Him. He is Not Limited to a Few Years Upon the Earth but has Existed and Will Exist Forever. He Begins to See that His Body is But a Shell, a thing to Use for a Brief Time but that His Real Being is His Spirit, His Soul, and that Lives On When the Shell of Earthly Skin and Bones Has Been Shed and Molders Away in the Earth.

Man Begins to See that Creation is Not Just the Material Things of the Earth and that Living Things are Not Just those Things and Beings that are Seen Here. He Begins to Realize and Understand there are Many Other Levels of Existence, Many Other Levels of Beings, and They All Are Part of God, Part of the Source of All Things, the Great I AM of I AMs.

In All These and indeed, Many More ways, Man has Limited Himself, His Perceptions, His Existence but as Man Sees and Accepts the Light and Love of God, All that Begins to Change and the Shackles and Bonds of Limitation are Broken and Flung Aside and the Child of Light Begins to Breathe Free and Independent as Part of His Rightful Heritage, a Party of God Himself.

This Entire Concept is Based On the Fear That There Is Not Enough. It is Based On the Concept of Limitation. This Fear says, "I have To Struggle and Slave and Work and Cut Corners and Even Cheat and Defraud In Order to Get Enough For Myself." This is the Greed that Runs Through All the History of Mankind. This is Like a Black Thread that Appears and Reappears on the Satiny Whiteness of a Holy Gown.

Many Humans have Fought and Struggled and Slaved to Get and to Get and to Get Some More and in the End it was Gone, for in the Next Life, on the Next Plane, there is No Taking Along What One Has Gotten in This Life and On This Plane.

It Sorrows Me and Causes Me Grief to See Man Struggling to Get and Get Some More, when There Is No Need. In the World, the Earth as You Know it, there Never Has Been a Time when There Wasn't Sufficient Food for Every Single Person Alive. Not Once has There Been Such a Lack that Someone, Anyone, had to Starve To Death. The Same can be Said of Clothing, Shelter, and Any Other Necessity of Life.

The Air Around Mother Earth is There in Such Abundance that No one Need Ever be Without. The Water in the Rivers, Lakes, Seas and in the Clouds and Air is Much More than Sufficient for the Needs of Every Soul that Ever Lives on Earth. The Fish of the Water, Birds of the Air and Animals of the Land are there in Such Abundance that No One Need Be Without, but May Have Sufficient of Whatever They Need of Them.

So it is that the Obsession of Man with, "Getting," is Needless and Indeed Useless. When Man Sees and Understands the Richness, the Abundance that Has Been Given by the Heavenly Father on this Earth for the Needs of Man, He will Stop the Struggle and Drive and Battle for Getting and Getting and Getting More and More and More.

"Be Content With Such Things As Ye Have," is a Saying Worth Considering and Imprinting Upon the Forehead of Thy Consciousness.

I have Spoken Only of Material Things, the Money, the Furniture, the Cars, the Appliances, the Clothes, and the Abundance of Food, Water and Air. There are Many More Physical Things that Could be Included and I'm sure You and any other Being on Earth can Readily Think of Many More of Them.

There is, however, a Knowledge, a Knowing, a Gift From on High that Can Shatter the Bonds of Limitation and the Fear of Not Having Enough. That is the Love of God for All Mankind.
